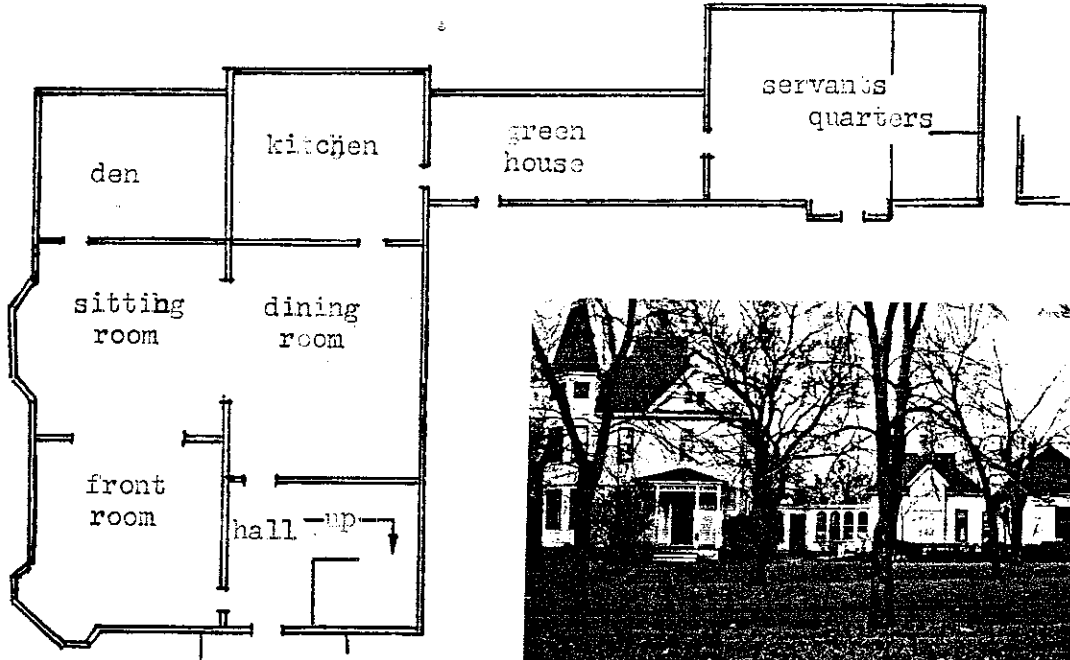

John Swartz Home

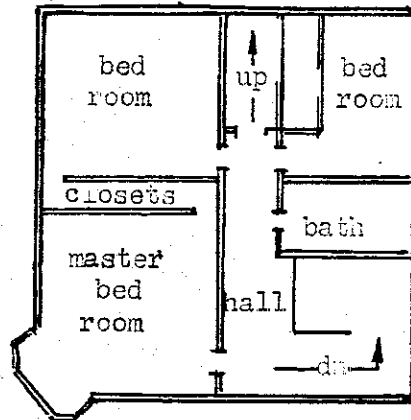


First Floor

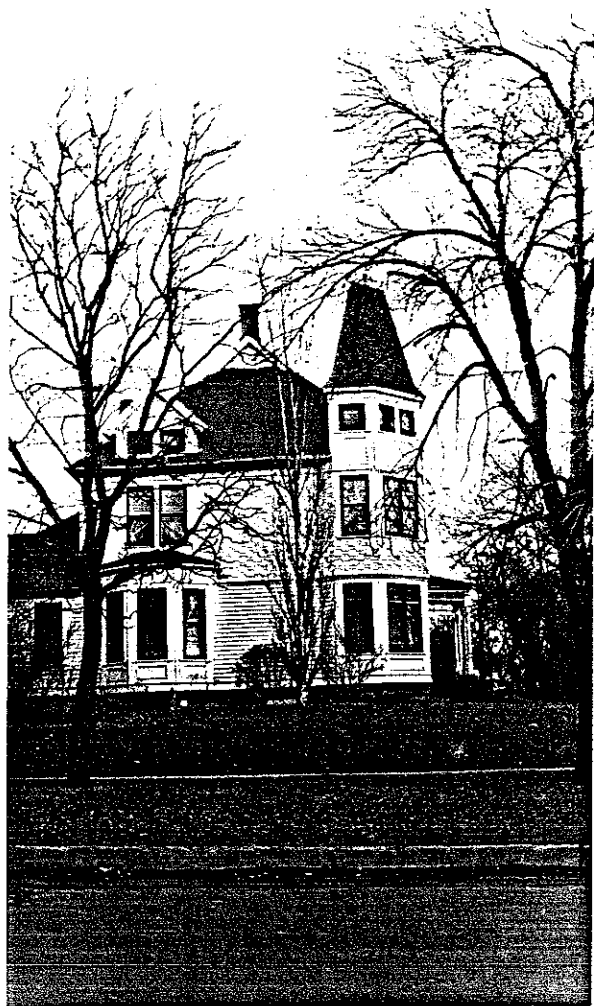


View from south

as a garage.



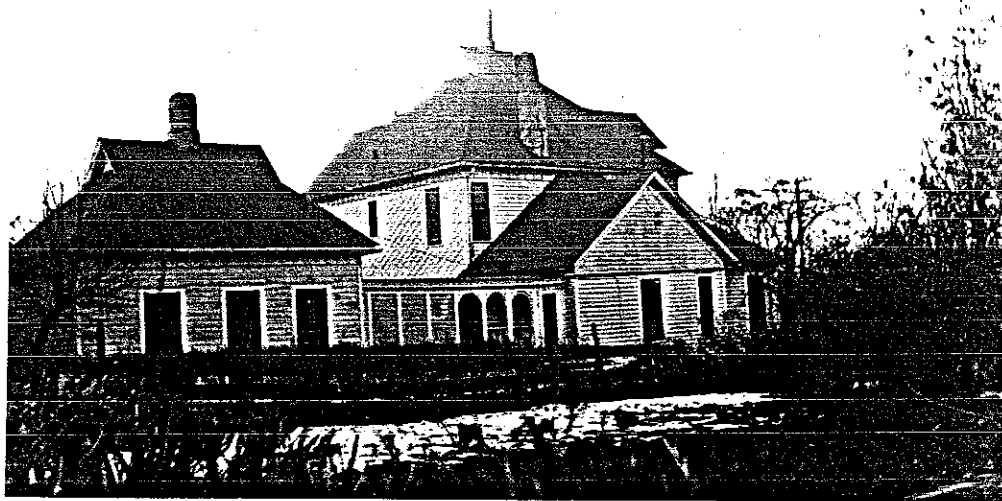
